

Ecosystem Transformation Workshops





Overview:

This series of participatory workshops will explore ecosystem change due to invasive species and wildfire, in a collaboration of researchers working directly with land managers and other practitioners through the existing NC RISCC network. This can be used to adapt management plans for important ecosystem services, such as carbon storage and biodiversity, that may be agency/organization specific to better align aspirations with action.

Goals:

The goals of these workshops are to 1) identify areas of transformation due to wildfire and grass invasion and 2) evaluate management practices that enhance carbon storage, native biodiversity, and improve resilience, including tradeoffs among priorities.
